The Verendrye Museum located at 115 Deadwood Street in Fort Pierre, SD is announcing the arrival of its new, one-of-a-kind cookbook, *Recipes & Memories COOKING UP HISTORY*. The profits will benefit the refurbishing of the Verendrye Museum, Fort Pierre's own unique historical collection of historical treasures.

Many present and former citizens of Fort Pierre, friends and family have donated their tastiest tried-and-true recipes and Karen Tufnell compiled them into a single book that will be treasured for generations to come. The mouth-watering cookbook contains 534 recipes – everything you need from appetizers to desserts. The index includes a special list of all 320 contributors, so it's easy to find the recipes of friends and loved ones.

Special features include several photos donated by former Fort Pierre people to jog memories. Plus there is a biographical section to read about family histories and their connection to the homesteading and building of Fort Pierre. There are little facts and quotes sprinkled throughout the book.
