Old Business

- Fort Pierre Chouteau:
 - A. Funding grants and donations
Kevin is expecting our Deadwood Out of City grant; we are waiting to hear from the Community Foundation and Mary Chilton DAR requests. Deb will write up a request to Modern Woodmen.
 - B. Bid specifications
September is the goal for completion of the tower part of the project. Rick Hahn is working with Brosz to revise the specifications for bid.
 - C. Mike Fosha, State Archaeologist will do an archaeological survey on May 23.
 - Additions to web site: National Guard Armory
