Old Business

- Fort Pierre Chouteau
 - Funding grants submitted by Don and donations recorded by Deb
 - Construction update: Paige and Jenna attended the initial ground disturbance and only one small piece found; footings have been poured and extra soil delivered. There was a ground breaking ceremony.
 - Thank you cards will be sent when project is complete and include an invitation to the grand opening Deadwood wants pictures of the completed project and will be invited to the grand opening.

This will also include education with more information about National Historic Register for realtors to share with potential and existing homeowners.
