

A friendly reminder to Fort Pierre residents of your responsibilities for sidewalks and with the cooler weather upon us the winter parking restrictions.

### **K-3-3 SIDEWALK OBSTRUCTIONS**

- A. It is unlawful for any person to obstruct or cause obstruction of a sidewalk, or to permit a sidewalk bordering upon real property owned by that person to be obstructed.
- B. For the purposes of this section, obstruction means the prevention or impairment of passage on the sidewalk by pedestrians or wheelchairs; sidewalk means a public way established for pedestrian and wheelchair travel.

### **K-3-5 ABATEMENT OF SIDEWALK HAZARDS**

- A. It is unlawful for an owner of property abutting a public sidewalk to cause or permit the accumulation of water, snow, or ice upon such public sidewalk to the extent that it poses a hazard or obstacle to persons lawfully utilizing such sidewalk.
- B. It is the responsibility of the owner of property abutting a public sidewalk to repair and maintain the sidewalk, keeping it free from defects that cause unreasonable hazards for pedestrians or wheelchairs.

### **K-3-8 VIOLATION**

Any person found in violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a \$50 fine. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense subject to additional imposition of fines in accordance with ordinance section T-1.

### **N-4-8.1 WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS**

All types of boats, campers, and recreational vehicles are not permitted to park on any of the traveled portion of the public right of way during the time period of November 15 until March 15 of each year for a continuous period of more than 24 hours.

### **N-4-8.2 FINE**

Any trailer or recreational vehicle found in direct violation of this ordinance shall be fined \$25.00 and the actual cost of removal and towing. The cost of such towing. The cost of such towing and any storage charges shall be paid to the city by the owner of the trailer or recreational vehicle in addition to the prescribed fine prior to release of said trailer or recreational vehicle.

#### **N-4-4 SNOW ROUTE DESIGNATION**

The following streets, avenues, drives, trails, and roads are declared emergency snow routes:

- the entirety of Deadwood Street, Verendrye Drive, Park Avenue, Sale Barn Road, Marion Street, Two Rivers Street, Port Charlotte Avenue, Rousseau Avenue, Laramie Trail, Telegraph Trail, Black & Yellow Trail, Prairie Villa Trail, and North 2nd Street; and
- 7th Avenue from Deadwood Street to Marion Street; and
- 5th Avenue East from Deadwood Street to Missouri Street then Missouri Street north from 5th Ave. to 6th Ave. then 6th Ave. east from Missouri Street to Marion Street; and
- 2nd Ave. east from 1st Street to Deadwood Street and Main Ave. west from Deadwood Street to 5th Street then 5th Street South from 5th Street to 1st Ave. then 1st Ave. from 5th Street to 2nd Street; and
- 4th St. north from Park Ave. to Cedar Ave. then west on Cedar Ave. to city limits; and
- Casey Tibbs St. South from Ash Ave. to Scotty Phillips Ave.; and
- Scotty Phillips Ave. East from 1st Street to Two Rivers Street and Laframboise Drive from Two Rivers Street to Scotty Phillips Ave.; and
- Skerrols Street from U.S. Highway 14/34 to Islay Ave. then west on Islay to Mull then north on Mull to Jura, then west on Jura to Tiree, then north and west on Tiree to Waldron Street, then south on Waldron Street to US Hwy. 14/34; and
- Lindsay Trail from Laramie Trail to Black & Yellow Trail.

#### **N-4-5 NO PARKING DUE TO AMOUNT OF SNOWFALL**

There shall be no parking on the emergency snow routes when there is more than two (2) inches of snowfall until the said routes have been cleared to the edges of the street and not until all snowfall has ceased.

##### **N-4-5.1 FINE**

Any vehicle in direct violation of this ordinance shall be fined \$50.00 and the actual cost of removal and towing if not removed within 24 hours of citation. The cost of such towing and any storage charges shall be paid to the city by the owner of the vehicle in addition to the prescribed fine prior to release of the vehicle.
