

BAD RIVER PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE LIGHTING PROJECT

Why light the bridge?

- It will become a night time attraction to be seen from the highway bridge, from Fischer Lilly Park, Downtown, the Missouri River and Pierre.
- To provide safety for crossing the bridge at night
- To increase activities and pedestrian traffic downtown and in the Park
- To carry out the original goals of **Future Fort Pierre** to enhance and beautify downtown
- To continue to carry out the **“Healthy Hometown”** vision for Fort Pierre “to provide more walking, biking and physical activity, places for social gathering, creating a vibrant downtown and beautiful gateway into the community”

What will the bridge look like?

Who is paying for the project?

- Private donations will fund the project
- City tax dollars will not be utilized other than the engineer fee required prior to bid letting (already paid)
- Donations will be tax deductible through Future Fort Pierre’s 501(c)3
- Checks should be made out to “Future Fort Pierre Bridge Lighting”

How are the colors controlled?

- Color combinations will be controlled by a computerized “Control Box” which will be located in the City shop building

What will be the maintenance issues? Who’s responsible?

- Because the lights are all LED systems, bulbs (or unit light sections), lighting will last for years. The replacement process is something City employees will be able to maintain.

Examples of lighting combinations:

- **Red, White & Blue** for the 4th of July Festivities/Memorial Day
- **Purple & Gold** for Stanley County High School Homecoming, etc.
- **Red & Green** for Christmas Tree Lighting
- **Multi Colors** for New Year’s Eve
- **Wedding Colors** for Wedding Parties at Fischer Lilly Park

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
