Emerald Ash Bore Infestation Plan

While Fort Pierre not been infested with the Emerald Ash Bore yet, the City and Arbor Board are implementing the following process to reduce the impact of such an infestation within the City.

- 1.) The Arbor Board and City have completed a tree inventory on public property including boulevards. Notices will be sent to adjacent landowners that have Ash trees in the boulevard.
- 2.) City will remove all Ash trees from public property unless arrangements have been made by the adjacent property owner to treat the tree (see 4 below).
- 3.) A reimbursement process is available for the adjacent landowner of an Ash tree removed from the boulevard. Contact the City Office 605-223-7690 for more information.
- 4.) Individuals interested in treating the Ash tree will need to contact the City Office 605-223-7690 for details/completion of proper forms.
 - *Treatment by an approved **Licensed** applicator is necessary
 - *Treatment is an on-going process
 - *Treated tree will need to be marked with a tag provided by City
