

PUBLIC NOTICE

The U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration (EDA) is considering a request for Federal assistance from City of Ft Pierre to construct a Tatanka Trails Project in Ft Pierre, Stanley County, South Dakota. Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, as amended, EDA is conducting an environmental assessment (EA) of the proposed project.

The project includes the following components: A recreational trail, including a pedestrian bridge over a planned deep-water marina entrance that connects to an existing trail system along the Missouri River, extending upstream to the Oahe; Downstream Recreation area and Oahe Dam Visitor Center, and downstream via historic downtown Fort Pierre to the Lewis and Clark National Historic Trail site at Fischers Lilly Park; Outdoor exhibits, an amphitheater, a buffalo statue and interpretive signage will be installed along the trail. The trail connects the visitor center plaza and the bridge plaza with an observation pier.

The project will be located within Section 38, Township 5 North, Range 31 East of the B.H.M.. Project information is available for review at City of Ft Pierre, 08 East 2nd Ave, Fort Pierre 57532, (605) 223-7690.
