

ORDINANCE NO. 1040

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE CITY OF FORT PIERRE, SOUTH DAKOTA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council, in and for the City of Fort Pierre, South Dakota:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated by the City Council, in and for the City of Fort Pierre, South Dakota, for Fiscal Year 2019, the following sum of money for the purpose, which is deemed necessary to conduct the indispensable functions of government, to discharge the duties which are the lawful duty of the City to discharge, and the expenditure of funds for the purpose and objects for which no provision was made in the annual appropriation ordinance to-wit:
