

ORDINANCE NO. 1057

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 809, CHAPTER A-4-2, DEFINING ELECTION WARD AND PRECINCT BOUNDARIES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council, in and for the City of Fort Pierre, South Dakota:

Section 1. That effective January 1, 2022 Ordinance No. 809 be amended in the following sections to read as displayed:

The City of Fort Pierre is hereby divided into three wards and shall be designated respectively as Ward One, Two and Three. The wards shall be described with certain street or avenue designations or other landmarks that border the wards. Any reference to street or avenue below shall mean an imaginary line running down the approximate middle of each street or avenue. The wards of the City of Fort Pierre are as set forth below and shown in the ward map thereof. **Any discrepancies shall be resolved by reference to the attached ward map rather than the physical descriptions set forth herein.** Any previous wards and precincts are replaced by those described herein and on the attached ward map.

A. First Ward: All of that portion of the City of Fort Pierre enclosed by a line starting at the Southern City Limit Line, wrapping to the Western City Limit Line, North to Buffalo Rd; then follow Buffalo Rd to Far West Rd, then East on Far West Rd to Sale Barn Rd; then South following Sale Barn Rd until Hwy 83, then South on Hwy 83 until 2nd Ave, then West three blocks on 2nd Ave until 4th St; then South one block on 4th St until Main Ave, then East on Main Ave three blocks until Hwy 83; then South on Hwy 83 until the Bad River, then follow the Bad River to the Eastern City Limit Line; then South on the Eastern City Limit Line until it connects to the Southern City Limit Line, ending at the starting point.

B. Second Ward: All that portion of the City of Fort Pierre enclosed by a line starting at the Eastern City Limit line adjacent to the Railroad that lies North of Royal Court, going South along the Eastern City Limit Line until Main Ave, then wrapping around the North side of the Bad River to Hwy 83; then North on Hwy 83 until Main Ave, then three blocks West on Main Ave until 4th St, the North one block on 4th St until 2nd Ave, then 3 blocks East on 2nd Ave until Hwy 83; then North on Hwy 83 until Sale Barn Rd; then West following Sale Barn Rd until Far West Rd, then West of Far West Rd until Buffalo Rd; then South on Buffalo Rd to the West City Limit Line adjacent to Buffalo Rd; the follow the West City Limit line west and North until Hwy 14, then East on Hwy 14 until Laramie Trail; then North on Laramie Trail until Lindsay Trail, then East on Lindsay Trail until Black & Yellow Trail, then North on Black & Yellow Trail until Prairie Villa Trail; then East on Prairie Villa Trail to Hwy 1806, then South on Hwy 1806 until Hwy 14; then East on Hwy 14 until Waldron St, then North on Waldron St until the North entrance of Tiree Drive; then East on Tiree Drive until Jura Ave, then East on Jura Ave to Iona St; South on Iona St to Islay Ave, then East on Islay Ave to Skerrols St; then South on Skerrols St to Hwy 14, then East on Hwy 14 until the Railroad Tracks adjacent to Royal Court; then follow the Railroad Tracks until it connects to the Eastern City Limit Line, ending at the starting point.

C. Third Ward: All that portion of the City of Fort Pierre enclosed by a line starting at the Northern City Limit Line, wrapping to the Eastern City Limit Line, South to the Railroad; then follow the Railroad Southwest to Hwy 14, then West on Hwy 14 to Skerrols St; then North on Skerrols St to Islay Ave, then West on Islay Ave until Iona St; North on Iona St to Jura Ave, then West on Jura Ave to Tiree Drive; then North on Tiree Drive until Waldron Street, following Waldron Street South until Hwy 14; then West on Hwy 14 until Hwy 1806; then North on Hwy 1806 until Prairie Villa Trail, then West on Prairie Villa Trail until Black & Yellow Trail; then South on Black & Yellow Trail to Lindsay Trail, then West Lindsay Trail until Laramie Trail; then South on Laramie Trail until Hwy 14, then West on Hwy 14 to the

Western City Limit Line; then North on the Western City Limit Line until it connects to the Northern City Limit Line, ending at the starting point.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of conflict only.
