

FORT PIERRE CITY COUNCIL  
APPROVED MINUTES  
REGULAR MEETING  
Monday, May 17, 2021

The regular meeting of the Fort Pierre City Council was held at the SD Municipal League conference room and called to order by Mayor Hanson at 6:30 pm. Members in attendance for Roll Call were Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun. Officials in attendance were Cromwell, Hahn, Heezen, Thorson, and Tibbs. Meeting was held via Zoom and in-person all motions are recorded as roll call votes.

**Approval of Agenda.** Bernhard moved and Kenzy seconded to approve the agenda. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

**Conflict of Interest Declarations.** No Conflict of Interest was declared.

**Reports.** 1.) Hanson shared Bob Ricketts thank you with council and gave a medical update on him. 2.) Hanson reported on the Agri-Business tour she participated in hosted by SDSU Extension that kicked off in Fort Pierre last week. 3.) Hanson gave an update on the Covid guidelines just released by the CDC. 4.) Heezen reported that Sales Tax through March was up 25% YTD, BBB for same period up 71% YTD, and Occupancy Tax for March is up 41.2%. 5.) Heezen informed Council on the time line for the temporary ordinance for the issuance of local medical cannabis. 6.) Heezen requested a Special Council Meeting for 5/20/21 to approve setting a public hearing for the medical cannabis ordinance. 7.) Heezen reported that staff is planning to open the pool around Memorial Day weekend possibly with limited hours. 8.) Hahn reported on the Code Enforcement Conference the Public Works Department attended at Drifters. 9.) Thorson informed council that the pool will be filled on Friday and they are working on the drainage ditch by Stanley Road. 10.) R Cronin, Expo Board member, informed council that the Expo parking lot will be crack sealed and chipped this summer. 11.) R Cronin reminded everyone not to park in front of fire hydrants even if not marked by yellow paint and asked if annual fire hydrant maintenance will be done on the fire hydrants in the City. Thorson informed council the fire hydrants are on an annual maintenance schedule for valve exercising/flushing.

**Consent Calendar.** Bernhard moved and R Cronin seconded to approve the Consent Calendar: Minutes-5/3/21 Council Meeting; Raffle Permit: Stanley County Wrestling-6/1 Wrestling Building Fundraiser. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

**Poppy Day Proclamation-Unit 20 American Legion Auxiliary.** Mayor Hanson read and presented a Poppy Day Proclamation to the Unit 20 American Legion Auxiliary. Gayle Stover and Betty Stratton were present to sell poppies and accept the Proclamation.

**Steamboat Mobile Home Court License Transfer to Teton River West.** L Cronin moved and Kenzy seconded to approve the Mobile Home Court License transfer from Steamboat Mobile Home Court to Teton River West. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

**Temp Liquor License-Chateau at the Pat Duffy Community Center.** Rathbun moved and Bernhard seconded to approve a Temporary Liquor License for the Chateau at the Pat Duffy Community Center on 6/12/2021. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

**MRES Dedicated Capacity Agreement.** Hahn explained to council this is a mutual agreement for generated power with MRES that is effective until 2052 and it had been reviewed by legal counsel. Bernhard moved and Kenzy seconded to authorize signing of the MRES Dedicated Capacity Agreement. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

**Part-Time/Summer Staff.** R Cronin moved and Iversen seconded to approve the following Summer Staff in Parks: Cormac Duffy at \$10.15/hour; Pool: Kolbi Solberg at \$13.15/hour Assistant Manager, Taya Briggs at \$10.15/hour, Mattie Duffy at \$10.15/hour, Ellie Simpson at \$10.65/hour. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.
