

FORT PIERRE CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
May 31, 2016

The regular meeting of the Fort Pierre City Council was called to order by Mayor Hanson at 5:15 pm. Members present for Roll Call were Bernhard, Cronin, LaRoche, Ricketts, and Weisgram. Gabriel was absent. Officials present were Cromwell, Hahn, Heezen, Thorson, and Tibbs.

Agenda. Weisgram moved and Bernhard seconded to approve the agenda as amended Motion passed on Voice Vote.

Conflict of Interest Declarations. No Conflict of Interest was declared.

Public Hearing. Ord #992, Rezone – Johnson. Mayor Hanson opened a public hearing at 5:16 pm for the purpose of getting public input on the rezone – Johnson from Residential A (Q-5-301) to Multi-Family Residential (Q-5-801). Present were Gary Johnson, Tina Titze, Lori & Mike Jacobson, and Jaci Keller. Titze voiced concerns regarding proper drainage of the area, she expressed that heavy rains could cause issues with the Brown/Johnson house. Titze mentioned the drainage ditch is filled in and felt that the plans and what the public had been told in previous meetings were not being adhered too. Hahn responded to Titze’s concerns that there are ditches and drop inlets in the grading and drainage plan once it is completed. Currently, he is working on getting easements to run some drainage to the North and there will be a Temporary easement until Skerrols is completed and connected with Vinton. Cronin expressed that this seems to be a positive project to increase housing and potentially increase enrollment for the school. Hearing no further comment, Hanson declared an end to the public hearing at 5:25 pm.

Final Reading Ord #992, Rezone – Johnson. Bernhard moved and Ricketts seconded to approve the final reading of Ord 992 – Rezone – Johnson. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

Personnel – Summer Staff-Park Labor. Cronin moved and LaRoche seconded to approve Summer Staff –Park Labor applicant Clayton Green for \$8.55/hr. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

E. Main & Deadwood. Ricketts moved and Bernhard seconded to approve the Asphalt Mill and Overlay estimate for E Main and Deadwood in the amount of \$227,372 as presented by Hahn. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

Reports. 1.) Heezen reported on meeting with Fema last week. 2.) Heezen handed out the flyer and explained the schedule on Ice Piggings for June 7th & 8th. 3.) Heezen explained the debt service payments to the council. 4.) Hanson reminded the council of the 2017 Budget Retreat on 6/14/16 from 3 to 6:30 pm.

Adjournment. Cronin moved and Ricketts seconded to adjourn the meeting at 5:41 pm.
