

**FORT PIERRE CITY COUNCIL**  
**REGULAR MEETING**  
**June 13, 2011**

The regular meeting of the Fort Pierre City Council was called to order by Councilman Bernhard at 7:30 pm. Members present for Roll Call were Briggs, Gabriel, Paul, Rathbun, and Ricketts. Officials present were Cromwell, Fischer, Heezen, Lawrence, and Thorson.

**Agenda.** Briggs moved and Rathbun seconded to approve the agenda. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Consent Calendar.** Paul moved and Briggs seconded to approve the following Consent Calendar items: 6/6/11 minutes. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Dunes Drive Levee Maintenance.** Rathbun moved and Ricketts seconded a motion of support on behalf of the residents of Dunes Drive to request the National Guard to patrol the levee on the east side of their homes and to keep an eye on their pumps. The residents of Dunes Drive feel this would provide additional protection for the levee constructed on Dunes Drive. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Fifield Check Dam Project.** Lawrence indicated that he would be opening quotes for the Fifield Check Dam project at 10:00 on 6/14/11. The completion of this project is a key factor to controlling run-off into the storm sewer system in a rain event. Both DOT and EOC support the project.

**Levee Maintenance.** Council discussed staffing needs for long-term levee maintenance and the need for establishing a contract for maintenance in the event of a levee breach.

**Pump Maintenance.** Council discussed pumping needs for both water infiltration and rain run-off. There is a need for pumps in at least 21 locations. Staffing issues and pump purchases will need addressed.

**Mosquito Spraying.** Thorson indicated that the parks department has started mosquito control measures. Aerial spraying of mosquitoes will be discussed at the 6/20/11 meeting.

**Watermain Extension – Malm.** Council discussed extending the watermain to the Malm residences, which would allow hookups to accommodate immediate and future needs in the area. Lawrence will get quotes for a future council meeting.

Rathbun moved and Paul seconded to pay the claims as submitted. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Reports.** 1.) Lawrence reported that ground water is having a significant impact in several locations. He is looking into some dewatering processes, planning to get further information and details on horizontal directional drilling. 2.) Lawrence indicated that A-Tech is coming to help investigate in a few areas where water is filtering into the sanitary sewer system. 3.) Thorson reported on staff allocation and scheduling. He is working on getting everybody a day or two off despite the work demands. 4.) Ricketts expressed concern about discharge from sump pumps onto other peoples property, requesting a resolution to address this issue. 5.) Rathbun indicated that B&B Equipment has expressed interest in having their contract for the 2010 Sanitary Sewer Project suspended until next year due to the inability to work in the project area as a result of flooding.

**Adjournment.** With no further business, Tidball declared the meeting adjourned at 8:55 p.m.
