

FORT PIERRE CITY COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING  
June 19, 2017

The regular meeting of the Fort Pierre City Council was called to order by Mayor Hanson at 6:30 pm. Members present for Roll Call were Bernhard, Cronin, Gabriel, LaRoche, Ricketts and Weisgram. Officials present were Cromwell, Hahn, Heezen, Thorson and Tibbs.

**Agenda.** Gabriel moved and Weisgram seconded to approve the agenda. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Conflict of Interest Declarations.** No Conflict of Interest was declared.

**Consent Calendar.** Cronin moved and Weisgram seconded to approve the following Consent Calendar items: 6/5/17 Minutes; 6/13/17 Minutes. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Public Hearing for 2017-2018 Malt Beverage License-Total Beauty.** Mayor Hanson opened a public hearing at 6:32 pm for the purpose of getting public input on the 2017-2018 Malt Beverage License for Total Beauty. **Reports.** 1.) Heezen informed council sales tax is down 11% YTD and BBB is up 27% YTD. 2.) Heezen informed council that three Fireworks vendors had turned in paperwork and she had also visited with the fire chief with concerns on the dry conditions. 3.) Heezen reported that the SDML Budget and Elected Officials trainings were 7/13 and 7/19. 4.) Hahn reported he had a request to put a floating dock on the drainage canal. 5.) Hahn informed council that the curb and sidewalk are near completion at Casey Tibbs Turn Out just waiting on spinner base from the Casey Tibbs Center. 6.) Hahn reported that Casey Tibbs Street pavement and east curb are removed. It was decided the west curb would also need replaced adding \$8,000 to the project. Wandel won't be started until after 7/4/17. 7.) Hahn informed council Family Dollar should be operational in about 3 months.

**Adjournment.** Cronin moved and Weisgram seconded to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 pm.
