

FORT PIERRE CITY COUNCIL
APPROVED MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
Monday June 21, 2021

The regular meeting of the Fort Pierre City Council was held at the SD Municipal League conference room and called to order by Mayor Hanson at 6:30 pm. Members in attendance for Roll Call were Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun. Officials in attendance were Cromwell, Hahn, Heezen, Thorson, and Tibbs. Meeting was held via Zoom and in-person all motions are recorded as roll call votes.

Approval of Agenda. L Cronin moved and Kenzy seconded to approve the agenda as amended. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

Conflict of Interest Declarations. No Conflict of Interest was declared.

Reports. 1.) Hanson informed council that Bob Ricketts had been selected as Parade Marshal for the Fourth of July parade. 2.) Hanson reported that the Enhancement District has informed her that the Bad River Bridge would be resurfaced this summer along with improvement work on SD Highway 1806. 3.) Hanson informed council she would like to schedule a council retreat for this fall. 4.) Hanson reminded council of the 2021 Elected Officials workshop on 7/14/21. 5.) Heezen reported that Sales Tax thru April was up 16% YTD and BBB for same period was up 26% YTD. 6.) Heezen informed council she had visited with the Fire Department to see if they have concerns with the discharge of fireworks with the dryer conditions this year. They indicated that they are prepared to proceed as normal and have planned accordingly. 7.) Heezen reported to council that Emergency Planning is doing a Hazard Mitigation meeting at 6:00 pm on 7/7/21 at the SD Municipal League conference room. 8.) Thorson informed council that the chip sealing had been completed and sweeping up the extra chips has begun.

Consent Calendar. Bernhard moved and Iversen seconded to approve the Consent Calendar: Minutes- 6/7/21 Council Meeting; Travel: Montana, Breitag, and Pearson-Wastewater 101 Class-Winner-6/29/21. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

Public Hearing-Temp Liquor License. Mayor Hanson called a public hearing at 6:40 pm to get public input on a Temporary Liquor License for the Casey Tibbs Rodeo Center for an event on 6/24/2021. She asked for proponents to the Temporary License. She heard none. She asked for opponents to the Temporary License. She heard none. Hearing no further comments, Hanson declared an end to the public hearing at 6:41 pm. R Cronin moved and Kenzy seconded to approve the Temporary Liquor License for the Casey Tibbs Rodeo Center event on 6/24/21. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

Set Public Hearing for Vacation Home Ordinance Ord #1050. Bernhard moved and Iversen seconded to set a public hearing for the Vacation Home Ordinance #1050. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

Personnel-Resignation. Iversen moved and Kenzy seconded to accept the resignation of Shane Nickels in the Street Department effective on 6/28/21. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

Personnel-Shane Pearson-Certification. Heezen informed council that Shane Pearson had received his Class III Water Distribution Operations Specialist certification. R Cronin moved and L Cronin seconded to approve the .60/hour raise for certification to Shane Pearson (\$26.27/hour). Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

Bids & Award for Street Surfacing. Kenzy moved and Bernhard seconded to accept the 4” asphalt bid from Morris Inc. for Project 1, S 2nd Street, in the amount of \$126,072.01. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye. L Cronin moved for Project 2, Rowe Lane, accept the Quality Construction bid for reinforced concrete in the amount of \$98,860.72. After further discussion, L Cronin chose to

rescind his motion. Bernhard moved and R Cronin seconded for Project 2, Rowe Lane, to accept Morris Inc. 6” asphalt bid in the amount of \$58,740.00. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye. L Cronin moved and Bernhard seconded for Project 3, School Alley, to accept Quality Construction’s bid of reinforced concrete in the amount of \$56,362.00. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, and Rathbun all voting aye. Kenzy voted nay.

Bids & Award for Curb & Gutter. Bernhard moved and L Cronin seconded to accept Anderson Contractors bid for Rowe Lane Curb and Gutter in the amount of \$73,159.00 Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

Bids & Award for Lagoon Improvements Project. Hahn informed council that there was only one bid received and it was \$900,000 over the Engineer’s Estimate timeline being the concern given. Rathbun moved and R Cronin seconded to reject the base bid from Sharpe Enterprises in the amount of \$3,585,665.00 which was approximately \$900,000 over Engineer’s estimate and rebid with extended deadlines plus a pre-bid meeting. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

2021-2022 Malt Beverage License-Family Dollar. Bernhard moved and Rathbun seconded to approve the 2021-2022 Retail (On-Off Sale) Malt Beverage with SD Wine License for Family Dollar. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

2021-2022 Mobile Home Court Licenses. The following list was presented: Travis Frost Mobile Home Court, River Bluff Estates, Schaefer Mobile Home Court, Teton River West LLC, and J&T Mobile Home Court. Kenzy moved and Iversen seconded to approve the 2021-2022 Mobile Home Court Licenses as presented. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

Advertise for Bids for Hay Ground. Bernhard moved and Iversen seconded to advertise for Bids on the City Hay Ground. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

Right of Way Closure Permit –Deadwood St from 2nd Ave to Main. Iversen moved and Bernhard seconded to approve the Right of Way Closure Permit on Deadwood Street from 2nd Avenue to Main Avenue for 8:00 am 8/14/21 to 1:00 am 8/15/21 for Trader Days Activities and a Street Dance. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun all voting aye.

Pierre/Fort Pierre Historic Preservation. Sunny Hannum gave a presentation on the updates to area historical signs the committee had completed. She also shared the historical publications the committee had printed this past year with the council.
