

FORT PIERRE CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
June 22, 2015

The special meeting of the Fort Pierre City Council was called to order by Mayor Hanson at 12 pm. Members present for Roll Call were Bernhard, Cronin, Gabriel, Ricketts, Rose, and Seiler. Officials present were Cromwell and Thorson. Also present were Cody Lemke, Fort Pierre Fire Department Chief and Kelly McCollam, Stanley County Superintendent.

Storm Clean-up. Council discussed the aftermath of the storm that came through earlier today and options for debris clean-up. Seiler moved and Bernhard seconded to approve hiring Tim Hughes (CCI), R&W Construction, and Cody Briggs (Briggs Trucking) at a rate of \$130/hour to load and haul debris. City staff, the US Forest Service, the Fire Department, and Stanley County will assist with the debris clean-up, including tree debris. In addition, the US Forest Service and the Fort Pierre Volunteer Fire Dept offered to help individuals who request assistance on personal property with trimming, cutting or removing trees, tree branches, or limbs, as long as a Hold Harmless agreement is in place. McCollam indicated that the tree debris could be deposited at the County pit. City will check with Corp of Engineers about the release of water to help address the concern of the high level of water in the Bad River. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

Adjournment. With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 12:33 pm.
