

FORT PIERRE CITY COUNCIL  
APPROVED MINUTES  
REGULAR MEETING  
July 15, 2019

The regular meeting of the Fort Pierre City Council was called to order by President Bernhard at 5:15 pm. Members present for Roll Call were Cronin, Kenzy, LaRoche, Ricketts, and Weisgram. Officials present were Cromwell, Hahn, Heezen, Thorson, and Tibbs.

**Approval of Agenda.** Kenzy moved and Ricketts seconded to approve the agenda as amended. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Conflict of Interest Declarations.** No conflict of interest declaration was declared.

**Reports.** 1.) Heezen informed council the first Farmer's Market for the summer would be 7/16/19. 2.) Heezen reported that work on the budget was beginning and some committee meetings would need to be scheduled. 3.) Hahn informed council that he has been working on the 4<sup>th</sup> Ave street project. 4.) Hahn reported that there is consideration for doing asphalt on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street between Park and Tim along with curb and gutter. 5.) Hahn informed council there were 5 Mobile Home Courts remaining to be approved. 6.) Hahn reported that lake levels remain high with the recent moisture and that Zebra Mussels have been found in Lake Sharpe. 7.) Cronin asked about the status of the water study being done. Hahn replied that the documents are being reviewed and he has met with WR/LJ and the water study engineers. 8.) Cronin asked about getting the bike/walking path opened back up by Drifters. Hahn had previously checked the area out when Cronin asked about opening it back up and determined there are some safety concerns with the high water levels and erosion in that area. 9.) Cronin had concerns with drainage in the Buffalo Road and Sale Barn Road areas due to plugged or caved in culverts. Hahn informed him the property owners will need to be notified of repairing/cleaning the culverts.
