

FORT PIERRE CITY COUNCIL  
APPROVED MINUTES  
REGULAR MEETING  
July 15, 2024

The regular meeting of the Fort Pierre City Council was held at the SD Municipal League conference room and called to order by Mayor Hanson at 5:15 pm. Members in attendance for Roll Call were Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Deal, Iversen, and Kenzy. Officials in attendance were Cromwell, Heezen, and Tibbs. Meeting was also held via Zoom.

**Approval of Agenda.** L Cronin moved and Kenzy seconded to approve the agenda as amended. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Conflict of Interest Declarations.** Deal declared a Conflict of Interest Declaration and will abstain from the Silver Spur Temporary Liquor Licenses for 8-9, 8/10, and ROW Closure Permit for the Silver Spur on 8/9.

**Reports.** 1.) Hanson reported she has received lots of appreciative comments about the City staff picking up branches after the weekend's wind storm. 2.) Hanson informed council she had included in the packet the letter from a resident and her response about the concerns of the long delays/detours caused by the street construction and replacing utilities on Yellowstone Street and 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue. 3.) Hanson informed council she had met with Rhea Waldman and Justin Heim to discuss potential adjustments that could be made on the remaining components of Tatanka Trail after bids for the pedestrian bridge came in higher than budgeted. One area is the landscaping plants, the Arbor Board, staff, and the ISG Architect are coordinating efforts. 4.) Hanson reported that several participated in the ribbon cutting for First Fidelity Bank. 5.) Hanson felt the Fourth of July parade was well attended and the downtown vendors were supported while taking in the B-1 flyover. 6.) Hanson reminded council of the Community Appreciation Event that will be held at the Expo on 7/24 from 4-8 pm hosted by Fort Pierre Tourism and the Fort Pierre Chamber. 7.) Heezen informed council it is "Budget season" so committee meetings will be scheduled. 8.) L Cronin asked what could be done for Rathbun Fireworks to protect their property from people continuing to use it as part of the road. 9.) Deal thanked the City and Fort Pierre Fire Department for a great fireworks display on the Fourth of July. 10.) R Cronin thanked the City, SC Law Enforcement, and Fort Pierre Fire Department for a great Fourth of July celebration. 11.) Colton Hipple, ISG engineer, updated council on the street construction projects. He said north 7<sup>th</sup> Street had failing tests, but did finally pass last Saturday; the north side work on Yellowstone Street started today; Creagor Court curb and gutter work is wrapping up and it will be ready to pave soon; 6<sup>th</sup> Street has about 1/3 of sub-base graded (there is some unstable materials in spots) once graded and base course added will move to west side and begin work.

**Consent Calendar.** Bernhard moved and Kenzy seconded to approve the Consent Calendar: Minutes: 6/28/24 Special meeting; Council meeting 7/1/24; Raffle Permit: SC Booster Club-Chase the Ace fundraiser 8/1/24. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**2025 Budget-Subsidy Requests-BBB & General Fund.** The following BBB funding requests were presented: 1.) Future Fort Pierre-\$5,000. 2.) Fairgrounds Operations-\$50,000 3.) **Western Dakota Regional Water-Cheryl Chapman.** Cheryl Chapman, Executive Director of Western Dakota Regional Water, updated council on their progress. She informed council the first step is a feasibility study and they have \$12.7 million of the \$13 million cost raised. Chapman explained Senator Rounds is working with Western Dakota Regional Water to help them obtain a partnership with the Bureau of Reclamation.

**ROW Closure Permit-Silver Spur-August 9-Main/Deadwood alley.** Deal explained it was for a dance in front of the Silver Spur and requested the ROW Closure from 4 pm to 12 am. L Cronin moved and Bernhard seconded to approve the ROW Closure Permit for the Silver Spur on August 9 from 4 pm to midnight east of the intersection of Deadwood Street and Main Avenue. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Temp Liquor License-Silver Spur-8/9.** Iversen moved and R Cronin seconded to approve a Temporary Liquor License for the Silver Spur on 8/9. Motion passed on Voice Vote. Deal abstained.

**ROW Closure Permit-Trader Days-August 10-Main/Deadwood.** Kenzy moved and L Cronin seconded to approve the ROW Closure Permit for Trader Days on 8/10/24 from midnight to 2 am on 8/11/24 on Deadwood Street from 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to Main Avenue including a 500' portion of Main Avenue east and west of the Deadwood/Main intersection. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

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**Temp Liquor License-Silver Spur-Trader Days 8/10.** Iversen moved and R Cronin seconded to approve a Temporary Liquor License for the Silver Spur on 8/10 for Trader Days. Motion passed on Voice Vote. Deal abstained.

**Temp Liquor License-Chuckwagon-Trader Days 8/10.** Bernhard moved Deal seconded to approve the Temporary Liquor License for the Chuckwagon on 8/10 for Trader Days. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Temp Liquor License-Chateau-Trader Days 8/10.** Deal moved and Kenzy seconded to approve the Temporary Liquor License for the Chateau on 8/10 for Trader Days. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Temp Malt Bev License-American Legion Post 20-7/24-Expo Center.** L Cronin moved and Deal seconded to approve a Temporary Malt Beverage License for the American Legion Post 20 on 7/24 at the Expo for the Community Appreciation event. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Set Public Hearing on 8/5 for Temp Liquor Lic-Casey Tibbs Rodeo Center-8/17.** R Cronin moved and Bernhard seconded to set a public hearing on 8/5 for a Temporary Liquor License for the Casey Tibbs Rodeo Center for an event on 8/17. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Advertise for Hay Ground Bids.** R Cronin moved and Iversen seconded to advertise for Hay Ground Bids with a minimum bid of \$600. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Temp Liquor License-MG Oil-Hopscotch-Trader Days 8/10.** L Cronin moved and Deal seconded to approve a Temporary Liquor License for MG Oil-Hop Scotch on 8/10 for Trader Days. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Public Comment.** Susan Spain, Post 20 Commander, expressed concerns about Sharpe needing to finish development before an easement for electric could be secured. She inquired about the Fire hall status in that area and requested a \$50,000 pledge from the City to get the ballfield moving forward. Spain also inquired about sewer services. Hanson responded to her and explained that Post 20 would need to meet with an Electrical Contractor to figure out the electrical needs before the City could complete a service and that Spain would need to stop by the office for a funding request packet.
