

FORT PIERRE CITY COUNCIL
APPROVED MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
Monday, August 16, 2021

The regular meeting of the Fort Pierre City Council was held at the SD Municipal League conference room and called to order by Mayor Hanson at 6:30 pm. Members in attendance for Roll Call were L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, and Kenzy. Bernhard was absent. Officials in attendance were Cromwell, Hahn, Heezen, Thorson, and Tibbs. Meeting was held via Zoom.

Approval of Agenda. L Cronin moved and Iversen seconded to approve the agenda as amended. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

Conflict of Interest Declarations. No Conflict of Interest was declared.

Reports. 1.) Hanson informed council that Trader Days was the best one yet and congratulated the committee on a job well done. 2.) Hanson reported to council she and Ron had attended the Energize Conference in Milbank, for cities with a population under 5,000 and spoke about the community garden. Fort Pierre is applying to be the host city in 2022. 3.) Hanson reminded council that the Country Cookin' Fundraiser for the Pat Duffy Community Center will be 8/18 at 5 pm. 4.) Hanson reminded council the City is still operating under water restrictions with odd number houses watering on odd days and even number on even days. 5.) Hanson informed council that the next meeting would be on Tuesday, 9/7 due to the Labor Day Holiday. 6.) Heezen reported to council that Sales Tax through June was up 32.52% YTD, BBB through June was up 99.29% YTD, and Occupancy Tax was up 22.56% YTD. 7.) Heezen informed council the pool had closed for the season on 8/15. 8.) Hahn reported to council there will be a pre-construction meeting with the contractor and engineer for the Lagoon project. 9.) Hahn informed council that there will be a FEMA CAV visit in September and currently the City is off probation. 10.) Thorson informed council they had the School alley/storm sewer just about complete. They had to repair a fire hydrant on Scotty Philip and Two Rivers. They would be installing a culvert in the 5th & 6th Street alley then hopefully start work on Second Street next week.

Consent Calendar. Bernhard moved and R Cronin seconded to approve the Consent Calendar: Minutes-8/2/21 and Special Meeting Minutes 8/10/21. Motion passed on Voice Vote.
