

FORT PIERRE CITY COUNCIL
APPROVED MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING
Thursday, September 2, 2021

The special meeting of the Fort Pierre City Council was held at the SD Municipal League conference room and called to order by Mayor Hanson at 12 pm. Members in attendance for Roll Call were Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Iversen, Kenzy, and Rathbun. Officials in attendance were Cromwell, Teizen, Hahn, Heezen, Thorson, and Tibbs. Meeting was held via Zoom.

Approval of Agenda. Iversen moved and Kenzy seconded to approve the agenda as amended. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

Conflict of Interest Declarations. No Conflict of Interest was declared.

Intro Ord #1053 Zoning for Medical Cannabis Establishments. R Cronin moved to introduce Ordinance #1053 Zoning for Medical Cannabis Establishments.

Intro Ord #1054 Licensing for Medical Cannabis. Rathbun moved to introduce Ordinance #1054 Licensing for Medical Cannabis.

2022 Budget Discussion. Heezen explained to council after the Street and Utility and Finance Committee meetings she made the recommended changes to the council through separate emails and received feedback that there were some changes that members would like to see to the following requests: Verendrye Museum, Fire Department operating, Fire Department building reserve and Fireworks.

L Cronin moved and Rathbun seconded to approve \$3,300 for the Verendrye Museum request to come from the BBB funds. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

R Cronin moved and Iversen seconded to approve \$96,400 for the Fort Pierre Fire Department Operating fund. Motion passed on roll call vote with Bernhard, R Cronin, Iversen, and Rathbun voting aye. L Cronin and Kenzy nay.

R Cronin moved and Bernhard seconded to approve \$7,500 for the Fort Pierre Fire Department Building Reserve fund. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

L Cronin moved and Kenzy seconded to approve \$20,000 for the Fireworks to come from the BBB funds. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

Rathbun moved and R Cronin seconded to have the \$7,500 for the Fire Department's Building Reserve fund to be removed from the park budget. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

Executive Session. L Cronin moved and Kenzy seconded to go into Executive Session at 1:55 pm pursuant to SDCL 1-25-2(3) to discuss legal matter with legal counsel. Motion passed on Voice Vote. Hanson declared an end to Executive Session at 2:06 pm.

Adjournment. Mayor Hanson adjourned the meeting at 2:06 pm.
