

FORT PIERRE CITY COUNCIL  
APPROVED MINUTES  
REGULAR MEETING  
Tuesday, September 5, 2023

The regular meeting of the Fort Pierre City Council was held at the SD Municipal League conference room and called to order by Mayor Hanson at 6:30 pm. Members in attendance for Roll Call were Bernhard, L Cronin, R Cronin, Deal, Iversen, and Kenzy. Officials in attendance were Cromwell, Hahn, Heezen, and Tibbs. Meeting was also held via Zoom.

**Approval of Agenda.** Cronin moved and Kenzy seconded to approve the agenda. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Conflict of Interest Declarations.** Deal declared a Conflict of Interest Declaration and will abstain from the Silver Spur Temporary Liquor License item.

**Reports.** 1.) Hanson informed council she would be attending the MRES Leadership Institute as an MRES Ambassador on Wednesday. 2.) Hanson reported to council that the Sculpture Committee had met and fundraising for the Bison Sculpture by Lopez has been achieved. They have also been contacted by a Chicago artist that is working on a memorial for Commander Waldron, a scale model, of the USS Hornet, that will be donated with an audio terminal of the story, the committee just needs to provide a weather proof display case. 3.) Hanson updated council on the joint meeting that Bernhard, R Cronin, Kenzy, and herself attended held with county and school representatives. Discussion on the proposed plan to rearrange the football field, installing new bleachers on the west side of the field and moving it enough to allow for a full 8-lane track, which would encroach on City property near the pool and small park area. Hanson pledged the City's cooperation in the project. 4.) Hanson informed council of the Peaceful Pines Meet & Greet taking place on 9/6 at Magpies. 5.) Hanson reported to council she had attended an Ambulance meeting and there is concern about proposed legislation to limit the air transports and could impact our current service with AMR. She is going to visit with our legislative representatives and the Municipal League on this issue. 6.) Hanson reminded everyone of the Buckin on the River event coming up at the Fairgrounds on 9/9. 7.) Hanson will be participating in the Mayor's Panel during the Municipal League Conference October 3-6 in Rapid City and asked if any of the council was interested in attending. Iversen plans to attend Thursday's session. 8.) Hanson informed council that Gary Heintz, who was instrumental in running the Western Dakota Heritage Festival until health issues arose, had passed and his funeral would be 9/8. 9.) Hahn reported that HME needs to finish work on 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue so it doesn't interfere with the Yellowstone Project. 10.) Hahn informed council he is working on the advertisement for re-bid of streets and will publish soon. 11.) R Cronin talked about the smoke in the air and informed council of the Cavour Fire Chief who lost his life in the line of duty. 12.) Shane Kramme informed council of the upcoming Highland Games taking place on 9/23 in Lilly Park and invited everyone to attend.

**Consent Calendar:** Kenzy moved and R Cronin seconded to approve the Consent Calendar: Minutes 8/21/23 Council Meeting and 8/30/23 Special Council Meeting. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Intro (First Reading) Ord 1067, General Fund & BBB Budget.** Bernhard moved to introduce Ordinance 1062, 2024 General Fund & BBB Budget.

**Set Public Hearing on 9/18/23-Retail (on-off sale) Wine and Cider License-Casey's.** L Cronin moved and R Cronin seconded to set a public hearing on 9/18/23 for a Retail (on-off sale) Wine and Cider License for Casey's General Store. Motion passed on Voice Vote.

**Temp Liquor License-Horse Races 10/7/23 and 10/8/23-Silver Spur-Fairgrounds.** L Cronin moved and Kenzy seconded to approve a Temporary Liquor License for the Horse Races at the Stanley County Fairgrounds on 10/7/23 and 10/8/23 for the Silver Spur. Motion passed on Voice Vote. Deal abstained.

**Temp Liquor License-Buckin on the River-9/9/23-Longbranch-Fairgrounds.** Kenzy moved and R Cronin seconded to approve a Temporary Liquor License for Buckin on the River at the Stanley County Fairgrounds on 9/9/23. Motion passed on Voice Vote.
